### Honors College Preparatory Diploma

The Diploma is designed for those students who possess outstanding academic skills in most areas. The student who obtains this diploma will be ready to attend high-ranking colleges and universities.

1. Requires 28 credits, 8 of which must be Honors, Dual Enrollment or Advanced Placement.
2. Requires a grade point average of 3.5 or more
3. Requires a score of 1290 on SAT or 29 on ACT

NOTE: Florida students who wish to qualify for the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship must meet specific requirements.

1. Requires 26 credits, 6 of which must be Honors, Dual Enrollment or Advanced Placement.
2. Requires an average of not less than 3.0
3. Requires a score of 1170 on SAT or 26 on the ACT.

NOTE: Students who wish to qualify for the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship must meet specific requirements.

1. Requires 24 credits to earn this diploma
2. Requires no less than 2.0 GPA
3. Take the SAT or ACT or send an exception letter

1. It requires 20 credits to obtain this diploma.
2. It requires 6 credits (600 hours) of work study or learning training.
